LATV Fest NextGen Submission Guidelines, Terms and Conditions
AS OF June 20, 2008

1. **HOW TO ENTER:** Submission begins on July 1 at 9:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time ("PST") and ends at 5:00 p.m. PST on July 23, 2008 (the "Submission Period"). You must mail DVDs or CD Rom's to the Festival office. The submission must be clearly marked with entrant's name and title of project.

Submission must comply with stated time limits. There is no entry fee. Failure to properly identify your entry, failure to comply with stated time limits, failure to provide completed application and failure to submit your entry in stated formats will be grounds for removal. Submission must be between thirty (30) seconds and six (6) minutes in length. Submission must be burned to disc as a NTSC DVD or as a QuickTime File DVD (frame size - 720 x 486, recommended encoding - Apple animation Codec). A QuickTime File on CD-Rom is also acceptable as long as it adheres to the QuickTime DVD specifications.

All submissions must include entrant's full name, company name (if applicable), complete address, daytime telephone number, email address, title of entry, logline of 25 words or less, running time, creator's production credits, name of individual or entity who is copyright owner of project, producer's bio, resume, television credits. You may enter no more than two submissions for consideration, and each entry must be submitted individually. At sponsor's sole discretion, entries will be discarded if video contains any pornographic material, illegal activity or extremely violent scenes. All entries must be received by following the instructions by 5:00 p.m. PST, July 23, 2008. Any submissions not accompanied by a release agreement will be discarded.

2. **COPYRIGHTS:** All videos submitted must be the original creation of the entrant, or the entrant must have the rights to the content. Copyrighted music may be used in video entries only with proper broadcast clearance. By submitting an entry, you represent and warrant that any video(s) you submit (a) are your original creation in accordance with these Rules, (b) have not been copied in whole or in part from any other work (c) do not violate or infringe any copyright, trademark or other proprietary right of any person or entity, and (d) are your property. Entrants assume all risk of lost, late, mis-directed, incomplete, corrupted, or illegible entries. All videos submitted, and all concepts or ideas contained or embodied therein, are and remain the property of the entrant, but will not be acknowledged or returned. Qualifying entries may be posted in whole or in part on Sponsor's promotional website or Sponsor's online partners' website at any time, if deemed appropriate by Sponsor.

3. **ELIGIBILITY:** Programs created or funded by broadcast or cable networks are ineligible.

Entrants must be 18 years of age or older. All videos produced after July 1, 2007 for broadband, Internet or mobile distribution are eligible and must not have been publicly televised on broadcast, cable or satellite television prior to the "Submission Period". International entries produced in foreign language must have English subtitles or be dubbed in English. All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply.

4. **SELECTION:** Submissions will be judged by festival programming committee. All qualifying entries will be pre-screened to assure they have met the submission guidelines before screening at the LATV Fest. Selections will be screened at the LATV Festival in Los Angeles, CA on July 30 - 31, 2008.

5. **GENERAL CONDITIONS:** By submitting to the LATV Fest, you grant Sponsor the right to include your video submission--in whole or in part--in a DVD or any other product that is a compilation or sampling of entries, such as a highlights reel for the 2008 LATV Festival.

Some or all entrants may be requested to participate in a number of customary promotional and publicity activities (public appearances, press junkets, interviews, etc.) to promote the LATV Fest.

By participating, each entrant grants to Sponsor and those acting pursuant to the authority of Sponsor (and agrees to confirm that grant in writing), the right to print, publish, broadcast and use, worldwide in any media now known or hereafter developed, including but not limited to the World Wide Web, at any time(s), the entrant's name, portrait, picture, voice, likeness, photograph submitted and biographical information as news or information and for advertising and promotional purposes without additional compensation or review, except where prohibited by law.
